




ZOOM IN: WEST MAIN STREET

- Fall 2022: \$80M allocated to Rochester with emphasis on placemaking, small business & commercial corridors, workforce
- Community input gathered for project ideas
 - Received proposals from West Main property owners
- West Main Gateway identified early on as a priority
 - Alignment with City of Rochester's Bull's Head
 Revitalization investments and targeted development
- Largest RRP project in portfolio with \$10M allocation









WEST MAIN GATEWAY

Goals

- 1. Provide funding for building renovations to expand neighborhood-serving businesses including retail, restaurants, and other services
- 2. Increase mixed-use opportunities along commercial districts on West Main Street between Broad Street and Genesee Street
- 3. Build the capacity of stakeholders to advance the development and growth of the commercial corridor


Community involvement

- NY Empire State Development leadership with program development












Who is eligible?

Small businesses and property owners along West Main Street between Broad Street and Genesee Street.

What type of projects?

Mixed-use and commercial properties
Site acquisition, Demolition, Renovations,
Remediation, New construction and build-out, New equipment purchases

How much money is available?

\$6 million TOTAL for West Main Gateway projects Up to 90% of total project costs or \$250,000 per property
